SUBJECT: Florida's Registered Sexual Predator/Offender Employment Address File

The Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) makes available a listing of Florida's registered sexual predators' and offenders' employment addresses via a direct electronic transfer process. Requestors can generate a file of sexual predators/offenders by county, multiple counties, or the entire list manually or create an electronic process to extract this list. Please note that information regarding sexual predators/offenders is amended in the FDLE registry system on a continuous basis as needed for accuracy, currency, and completeness. These amendments update FDLE's Florida Sexual Offender/Predator Public Registry website on a real-time basis. This listing, particularly with reference to employment addresses and named individuals, is updated every four hours and is consequently obsolete as soon as the file is generated.

FDLE strongly recommends that the following warnings be included on any subsequent dissemination of the information:

- 1) Positive identification cannot be made without a fingerprint comparison; and**
- 2) This information is provided as a service for the public's benefit and may not be used in the perpetration of any criminal act or harassment against these individuals.**

The following URLs will allow a user to create an automatic download of the employment address data file for either a specific county or the whole file. Within the URLs below, users should replace EMAIL with a valid email address and COUNTY with the specific county to download:
