SUBJECT: Pearson VUE System Offline

Pearson VUE, FDLE's contract provider for the Basic Abilities Test (BAT) and State Officer Certification Exam (SOCE) will be transitioning its production environment to a new data center.

The cutover will take place between Friday, October 11, 2024, at 1 p.m. U.S. Central Time and Sunday, October 13, 2024, at 9 a.m. Central Time. There will be several systems/functions unavailable during this outage period, including but not limited to:

- Pearson account creation
- scheduling, rescheduling, and cancelling of appointments
- delivery of the Basic Abilities Test (BAT) or State Officer Certification Exam (SOCE)
- exam results and score reports
- statistical reports

Pearson indicates that following the cutover, once all services are restored, candidates can expect a seamless transition back to normal operations.
