

FDLE Florida Leadership Academy Class 62 Application Instructions and Link

The Florida Department of Law Enforcement, Florida Criminal Justice Executive Institute's Florida Leadership Academy (FLA) will be accepting applications for Class 62 between September 01 and October 15, 2025.

Before completing the online application, qualified applicants must prepare the following documents, which can be found on the FCJIEI website:

- Nomination form and Statement of Commitment completed by applicant's supervisor
- The Applicant Statement of Commitment Form
- Chief Executive Certification Form
- Completed leadership essay

To qualify for the program, applicants must:

- Occupy a criminal justice position that includes full-time, permanent responsibility for the supervision of others.
- Currently hold the rank or position of a first-line supervisor who does not oversee other supervisors.
- Show an employment history of increasing leadership responsibilities.
- Have the written nomination of his/her immediate supervisor indicating the applicant's potential for advancement in criminal justice.
- Have the written endorsement of the agency chief executive pledging their support for the applicant's participation in the program.

FLA Class 62 will be held at the Fernandina Beach Police Department, 1525 Lime Street, Fernandina Beach, FL, during the following dates:

Session 1

January 26 – 30, 2026

Session 2

February 23 – 27, 2026

Session 3

March 23 – 27, 2026

Session 4

April 20 – 24, 2026

All accepted applicants are responsible for a \$1,000.00 tuition fee, lodging, travel and food. A group rate of \$167 per night has been arranged at the host hotel (if needed).

Do not send the tuition fee until you are notified that you are accepted into the program. We typically receive more applications than we have available seats in the class.
