**(U//) Request for Information: Ginnie Springs Homicide**

The Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE), Jacksonville Regional Operations Center (JROC) is investigating the homicide of Marco Mandujano at Ginnie Springs Park in Gilchrist County, Florida during the 2024 Memorial Day weekend. On Saturday, May 25, 2024, at approximately 11:30 pm a fight broke out near the Devil's Spring and the Tube Launch. Marco was not involved in the fight but was shot and killed as he was walking through the area with his close friends and girlfriend.

FDLE is asking for the public's help in identifying those who have **ANY** information including but not limited to: another victim who was struck in the head with a glass bottle during the fight, the homicide, or people who were present at the park in this area during the time leading up to, during, and after the homicide.

Many attendees of the Memorial Day weekend event at Ginnie Springs are from outside the local area with some traveling from multiple states away.
