Citizen of the Year Award	Activity resulted in the prevention of an abduction, or the recovery of a child or endangered person from a situation of imminent danger. *Sworn law enforcement may not qualify for this award UNLESS the activity is grossly outside their normal job activities and occurred while off-duty. For example, sworn jail personnel that prevented a child abduction at a bus stop may qualify.			
School Bus Operator of the Year Award	Activity resulted in the prevention of a child or student abduction or the recovery of a child or student from a situation of imminent danger while on duty as a school bus operator/driver. *Must be employed as a school bus driver. Any other type of bus driver would be assessed for Citizen of the Year award.			
Young Hero Award	While a minor, activity that resulted in the prevention, escape or situation of imminent danger typically related to a child abduction or recovery of a child (could be the prevention/escape of their own abduction).
