We welcome your participation in the annual Florida Missing Children's Day Poster Contest!

The Florida Poster Contest winner will be invited to Florida Missing Children's Day, which will be held on Monday, September 14, 2026, in Tallahassee, Florida. The winner will receive an award and prize package during the ceremony.

Contest Rules

Students must create a poster that demonstrates the theme:
"Bringing Our Missing Children Home"

1. The finished poster must be 8½ by 14 inches.
2. The slogan "Bringing Our Missing Children Home" must appear somewhere on the poster.
3. Posters must be created by hand. Posters with printed images, collages, and stamping are not eligible.
4. Posters should be original in design. Be creative! Use acrylics, watercolor, pencil, charcoal, magic markers, spray paint, crayons, pastels, etc.
5. The physical poster must be submitted with a completed application, which includes a description of the poster, a brief biography of the artist, AND a signed parental release form. 6. Posters must be submitted via mail to the Florida Department of Law Enforcement, Attn. MPOE Operational Support, P.O. Box 1489, Tallahassee, FL 32302.

All posters must be received by Friday, March 20, 2026.
